Community Lands and Resources Committees (CLARC)

Since June 1, 2015, Qikiqtani Inuit Association has been implementing policy to recover honorarium paid to CLARC members. The policy has been applied to the following:

- CLARC review of any Application to Access Inuit Owned Land related to industry, government, and research
- CLARC meetings required pursuant to the terms and conditions of an IOL access authorization
- CLARC member(s) participation in QIA land use site inspections
- By formal request, CLARC participation in any community engagement or consultation sessions from industry, government, and researchers

Community Land and Resource Committees (CLARCs) are advisory to the Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA). QIA has CLARCs in each of the 13 communities in the Qikiqtani Region. CLARCS were created to ensure Inuit at the community level have an opportunity to be involved in land management and land use. CLARCs are involved in reviewing land use projects on both Inuit Owned Lands and Crown Lands and more recently various groups through community engagement have begun to seek and rely on their expertise. CLARCs play a very important role in ensuring that local land knowledge is available and contributes to land and resource management decisions.
