IN MEMORY - MISHAK ALLURUT

QIA is deeply saddened by the passing of Mishak Allurut earlier in 2023. Mishak was one of the first Nauittiqsuumiit, working as Nauittiqsuumiit Coordinator in Arctic Bay when the pilot project launched in 2018. For over five years, Mishak contributed immensely to the Nauittiqsuumiit program, sharing a wealth of knowledge with his crew and passion for harvesting with his community.

Mishak was a community leader and interpreter with a masterful command of Inuktitut. He spent time working in a variety of positions such as Wildlife Officer, Community Engagement Coordinator for SmartIce, and Planning and Lands Officer. He was married with seven children; three biological and four adopted, as well as several grandchildren.

Qikiqtani Inuit Association thanks Mishak for his contributions to the Nautiqsuqtuit program, his community, and his family. He will be missed.

EVOLUTION OF QIA'S NAUTTIQSUQTIIT

In 2018, QIA launched the Tallurutiup Imanga Nautiqsuqtuit pilot program in Arctic Bay. This was an early benefit to the Tallurutiup Imanga National Marine Conservation Area Inuit Impact and Benefit Agreement funded by Parks Canada.

With the success of the pilot project, the Nauvitiusuqtuit program was expanded to the other four Tallurutiup Imanga communities of Clyde River, Grise Fiord, Pond Inlet, and Resolute Bay.





In 2021, QIA was excited to announce the expansion of the Nautiqsuktuit program to Sanikiluaq as an early benefit agreement of the anticipated establishment of Qikiqtait Marine Protected area. The early benefit agreement between QIA and Department of Fisheries and Oceans Canada provided support for the creation of seven full time jobs, training courses, equipment purchases, and Nautiqsuktuit program development.

Further expansion of QIA's Nauittiqsuqtit program throughout the Qikiqtani Region has begun, with Inuit stewards hired in Kimmirut in 2022 and Qikiqtarjuaq in 2023.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT AREAS OF FOCUS

The Nautiqsugtuit program formalizes Inuit roles in environmental stewardship and harvesting in the Qikiqtani Region. It also provides a foundation for training, jobs, and other economic opportunities for Inuit.

As stewards, the Nauvitqsuqtuit use their knowledge of the local landscape to monitor sea ice conditions for safe passage and lend a hand to search and rescue efforts in the community, using their knowledge of fellow community members and the local landscape to help rescue community members in need.

The Nautiqsugtuit also bridge the gap between youth and Elders. The skills and Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit they acquire from working with Elders are passed down to young Inuit eager to learn on-the-land skills.

TALLURUTIUP IMANGA NAUTTIQSUQTIIT FULL TIME POSITIONS

In February 2023, QIA was excited to announce that 25 Nautiqsuktuit positions would increase from part-time to full-time hours. QIA is investing \$4 million towards making five Nautiqsuktuit in each Tallurutiup Imanga community of Arctic Bay, Clyde River, Grise Fiord, Pond Inlet, and Resolute Bay full-time employees over the next three years. Prior to this, Nautiqsuktuit have been hired as part-time employees.

As full-time employees, Nautiqsuumiit will be able to dedicate more time to supporting community members to access country food and gathering much needed data about the surrounding areas.

The funding to support the part-time positions was negotiated as part of the Tallurutiup Imanga IIBA through Parks Canada Agency. The supplemental funding to transition to full-time positions comes from Government of Canada's Harvester Support grant.

GROWTH OF THE NAUTTIQSUQTIIT PROGRAM

With the expansion to Sanikiluaq, Kimmirut, and Qikiqtarjuaq, there are now seven communities in the Qikiqtani Region with a Nauittisugtuit program.

This year, QIA focused on ensuring each community was well equipped to run their programs effectively. This included purchasing new trucks, snowmobiles, and ATVs which were delivered to communities in summer 2023. Resolute Bay and Qikiqtarjuaq both received boats and to assist with patrols, wildlife monitoring, and harvesting animals.

Communities also received lumber to build temporary shops for Nautiqsuqtuit use and emergency cabins for community members to use while out on-the-land. Arctic Bay and Clyde River both completed cabin construction this spring.



TALLURUTIUP IMANGA INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRESS

QIA was excited to see on-the-ground work happening on the Tallurutiup Imanga multi-use facilities.

In Resolute Bay, QIA is renovating the old Co-op hotel, and it is slated to open as Resolute Bay's multi-use facility in summer 2024.

Work has started on the Arctic Bay multi-use facility and will continue until its opening in summer 2024 as well.

Work on the Pond Inlet Inuit Research and Training Centre has begun and its opening is anticipated in 2026.

Work in Clyde River, Grise Fiord and Pond Inlet will begin over the next 1 – 2 years as funding is secured.

The multi-use facilities have been designed with dedicated space for Nauvitiusuqtuit workshops and offices, as well as space to engage community members in demonstrations and country food processing.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT SUPPORT FOOD SOVEREIGNTY

An important part of the Nauvitqsuqtit work is harvesting and sharing their catch with communities.

Harvesting not only provides food for those in need but is part of the Nautiqsuumiit monitoring work. Data collected provides valuable information about wildlife in the area and impacts of climate change.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT TRAINING EVENTS

The Nautiqsugtuit crews had a busy year both learning and teaching. They attended workshops and training events, learning information and skills to support their daily activities. They also provided valuable knowledge to stakeholders, QIA, and other Nautiqsugtuit.

In January, two Nautiqsuumiit from each community participated in an Environmental Response Program delivered by Transport Canada. Nautiqsuumiit learned how to identify vessels and what to do if they witness an oil spill.

Transport Canada returned to the Qikiqtani Region to provide a radio operator course in Pond Inlet. Throughout this course, the Nautiqsuumiit and Transport Canada solidified ways in which they can collaborate and support one another.

ALL-STAFF MEETING

In September, the Department of Marine and Wildlife hosted the Nauittiqsuqtuit in Resolute Bay for the annual all-staff training week. During this week the Nauittiqsuqtuit had a chance to tour the Resolute Bay multi-use facility, receive training and information about QIA's activities, as well as participate in team building activities.

This year Sanikiluaq Nautiqsuqtuit treated the other Nautiqsuqtuit crews to a traditional knowledge workshop on making smoked beluga sausage. The Nautiqsuqtuit and community members of Resolute Bay were taught to make this local Sanikiluaq delicacy, which demonstrated new ways to use maktaaq and other traditionally harvested animal products.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT WELCOME ALASKAN INUIT DELEGATION

In September 2023, QIA hosted ten Inuit from Nome, Alaska and surrounding communities. The delegation visited the Qikiqtani Region to learn about QIA and observe how Nautiqsuumiit operate in hopes of creating their own similar program.

The Alaskan delegation first visited Iqaluit where they were treated to a country food potluck and boating in Frobisher Bay and were provided information on QIA and the Nauittiqsuqtiiit program. They then traveled to Pond Inlet to observe the Nauittiqsuqtiiit program at work. The Pond Inlet crew took the delegation boating and harvested five seal, which were shared at a community feast.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT SPOTLIGHT: SANIKILUAQ'S COMMUNITY OUTREACH

As the part of the early benefit agreement of the anticipated establishment of Qikiqtait Marine Protected Area, two Nauittiqsuqtuit were hired in Sanikiluaq. Mick Appaqaq is the Nauittiqsuqtuit Supervisor and Thomassie Oqaituq is currently working as a casual Nauittiqsuqtuit. Both were hired to deliver key Nauittiqsuqtuit programming, including monitoring wildlife and sea ice, harvesting for their community, and sharing their extensive knowledge of the land.

Sanikiluaq's Nauittiqsuumit have hosted several community outreach programs, focusing on bringing youth and Elders together.

The Nauvitqsuqtuit organized a soapstone mining program where six youth learned how to harvest soapstone locally and bring it back to the community to provide to carvers. In Sanikiluaq, soapstone mining has not happened for a few years, and this was an opportunity for youth to learn this cultural skill.

Other programs have included speaking at the local school, qamutik making and youth harvesting programs. Local Elders and Nauvitqsuqtit worked together with five youth to construct qamitiks. One of the qamitiks was provided to Sanikiluaq's Hunters and Trappers Association to support harvesting. Harvesting trips included taking youth out on-the-land to catch eider ducks and seal. From the harvests, seal skins and eider down were provided to local seamstresses.

NAUTTIQSUQTIIT SPOTLIGHT: KIMMIRUT NAUTTIQSUQTIIT SUPPORT THEIR COMMUNITY

In 2022, QIA hired Killiktee Padluq as the Nauvitsoqtiit Community Supervisor in Kimmirut. This year, Killiktee hired Kooyoo Simigak as a casual Nauvitsoqtiit to support him in many of the Nauvitsoqtiit activities. Funding for the Kimmirut Nauvitsoqtiit program comes from Nutrition North Canada's Harvesters Support Grant.

The two Nautiqsuqtuit have been working hard to support community members. In summer 2023, Killiktee and Kooyoo took community members out on-the-land that do not have access to hunting or fishing equipment. All harvests were shared with Kimmirut community members to support food security. Throughout the year, Killiktee provided sealskins for workshops on skin preparation and making mitts.



During the spring, Kiliktee diligently monitored ice conditions and provided reports to community members to allow for safe passage while hunting or traveling. The sea ice monitoring is an important part of the Nautiqsuktuit work not only to keep community members safe but to monitor the effects of climate change.

QIA has received praise for the work that Killiktee and Kooyoo have done for their community, including community engagement, community cleanups, and their desire to help Elders and other community members.
