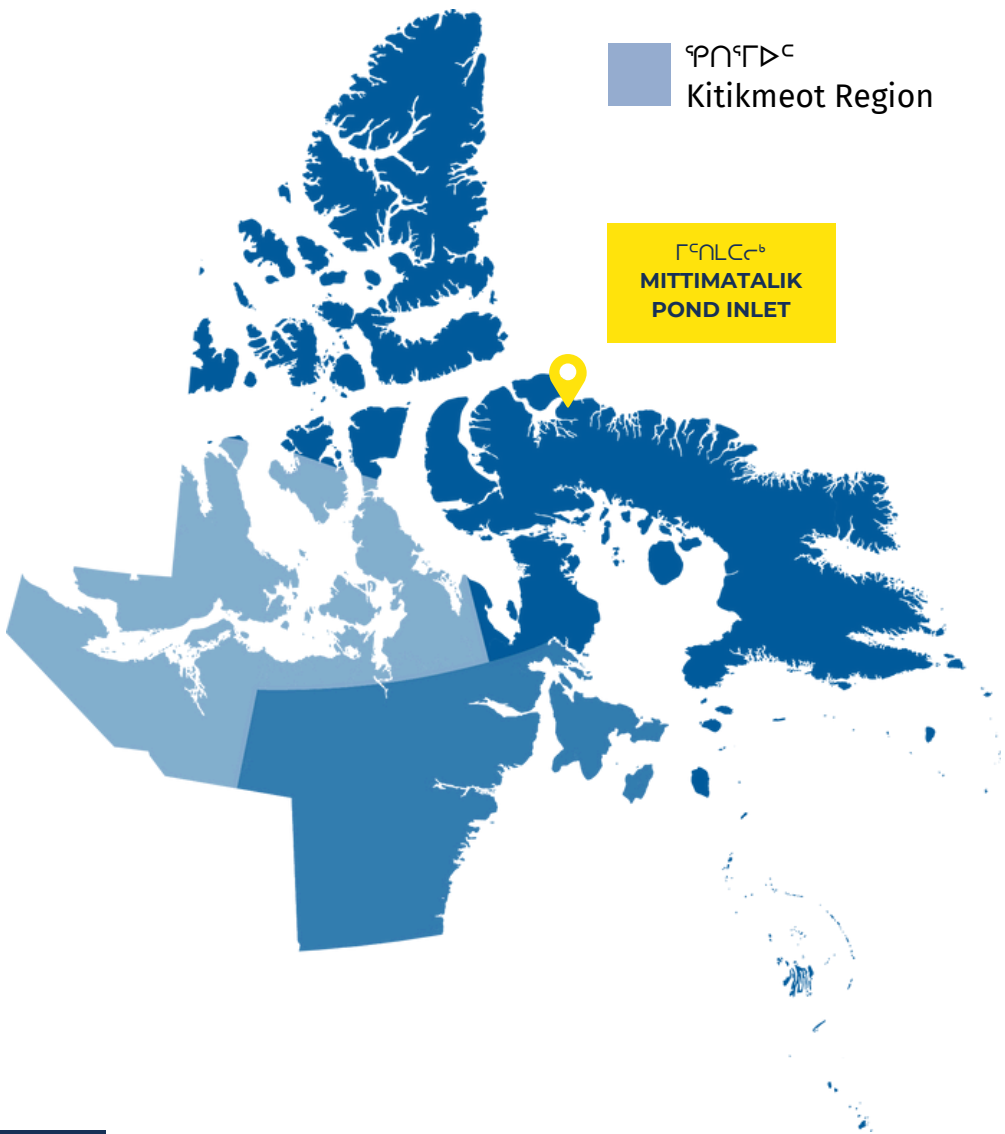

As the first facility of its kind in the High Arctic, the Centre will revolutionize access to university-level programming, ensuring Inuit can pursue educational opportunities without leaving their homeland.





Our Inuit Research and Training Centre located in Pond Inlet, Nunavut will be opening in 2026 and offers:

- Over 2,880 sqft of flexible classroom space with video conferencing, smart technology and high-speed internet
- Full-service cafeteria
- Onsite dormitories for up to 33 people with a student lounge and study space
- Laboratory facilities
- Heavy equipment simulators
- Up to 2,390 sqft of meeting and event space
- Highly energy efficient building designed with off-grid capabilities
- A location with a unique learning environment with cultural, environmental and regional factors to enhance education







The Centre intends to host in-demand programming and skills development in areas such as:

- the conservation economy
- Inuit governance
- mining and trades
- Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit
- science and research

Through partnerships, the Research and Training Centre can expand to offer university education and training in highly needed professional fields such as:

- medicine
- engineering
- information technology

This initiative empowers Inuit students with culturally rooted, home-based learning that connects them to their community and traditions.
